The escalating U.S.-Israel-Iran war has drastically disrupted maritime traffic, reigniting fears of profound stagflation and extended supply-chain paralysis.

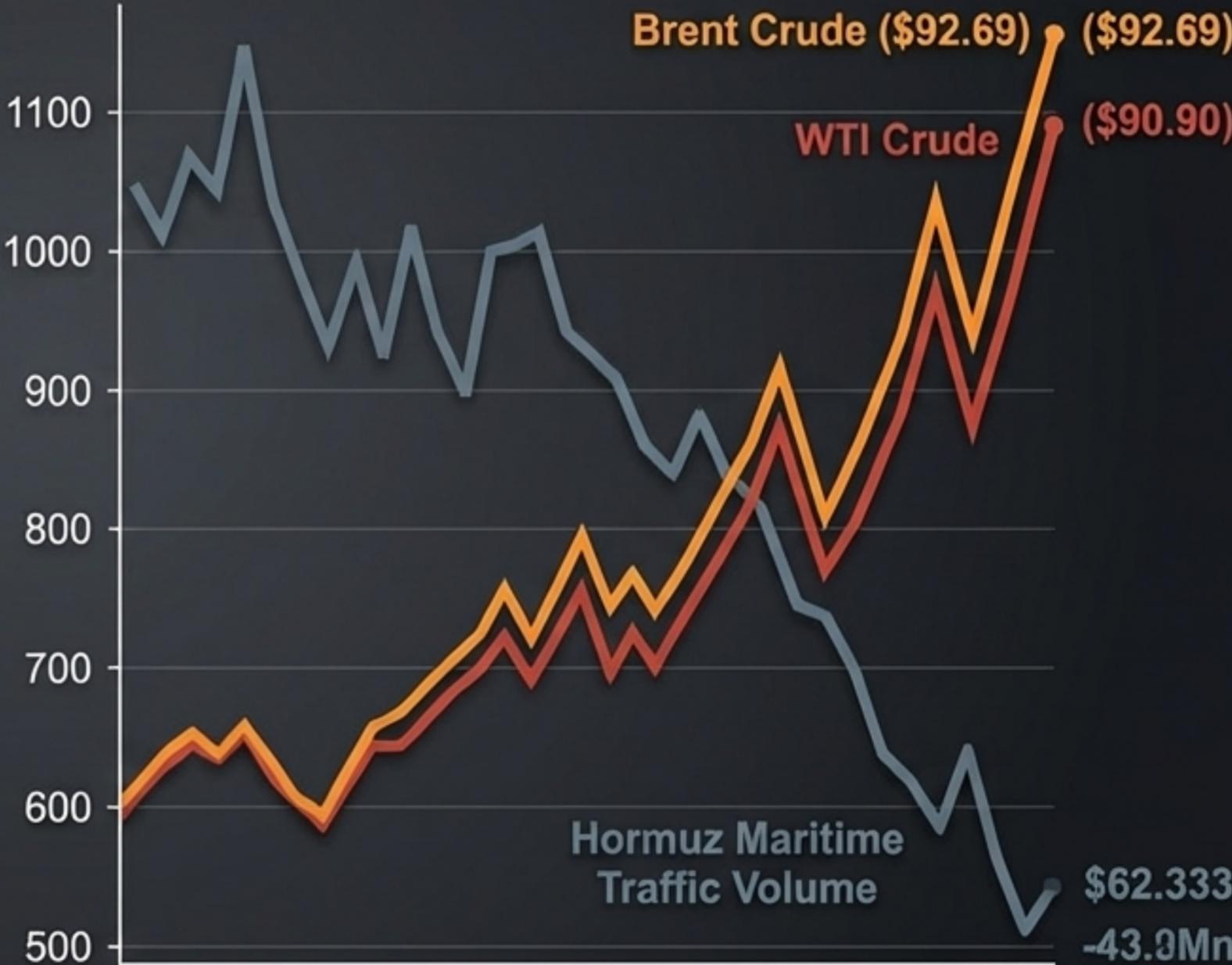
Data Breakdown:

WTI Crude erupts +12% to close at \$90.90/bbl; Brent Crude rockets to \$92.69/bbl (+8.52%); Natural Gas catches aggressive bids at \$3.186 (+6.09%).

Analyst Insight:

Until maritime transit normalizes, energy markets will remain hyper-inflated. Expect violent intraday swings on any military headlines; prolonged conflict risks pushing crude toward \$150.

SECTION 1: GLOBAL MACRO SHIFTS

Executive Title: U.S. Labor Contraction & The Fed Trap

Key Insight: The traditional 'bad news is good news' paradigm has failed. The Fed cannot cut rates to save the labor market because the exogenous oil spike threatens to re-accelerate inflation.

Data Breakdown: February NFP loss of 92,000 jobs; U.S. 10-year Treasury yield hovering stubbornly high reflecting sticky inflation premiums.

Strategic Action: Prepare for an environment where yielding assets suffer. Capital is being forced into non-yielding safe havens as high-beta assets de-leverage rapidly.



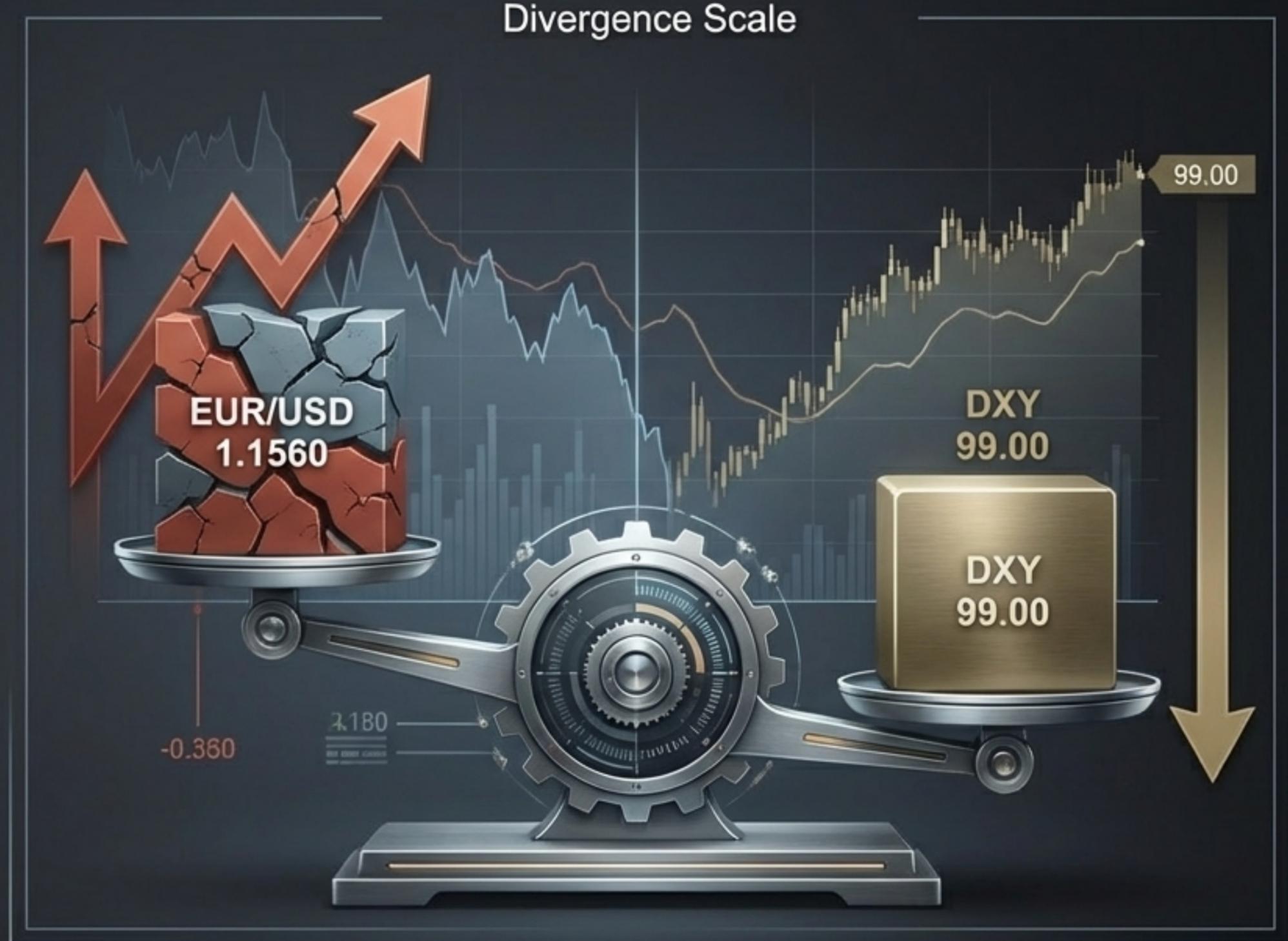
SECTION 1: GLOBAL MACRO SHIFTS

Executive Title: Monetary Policy & Forex Liquidity Refuge

Key Insight: Currency markets are dominated by safe-haven flows and monetary policy divergences, devastating regions with extreme vulnerability to Middle Eastern energy shocks.

Data Breakdown: U.S. Dollar Index (DXY) stabilizes at 99.00; EUR/USD pair dives below the 1.1600 handle to trade near 1.1560 (lowest since Nov 2025); USD/JPY hovers near 156.00.

Analyst Insight: The DXY is acting as the primary fiat liquidity refuge. Immediate technical support for EUR/USD is 1.1500, with further downside expected if energy paralysis persists.



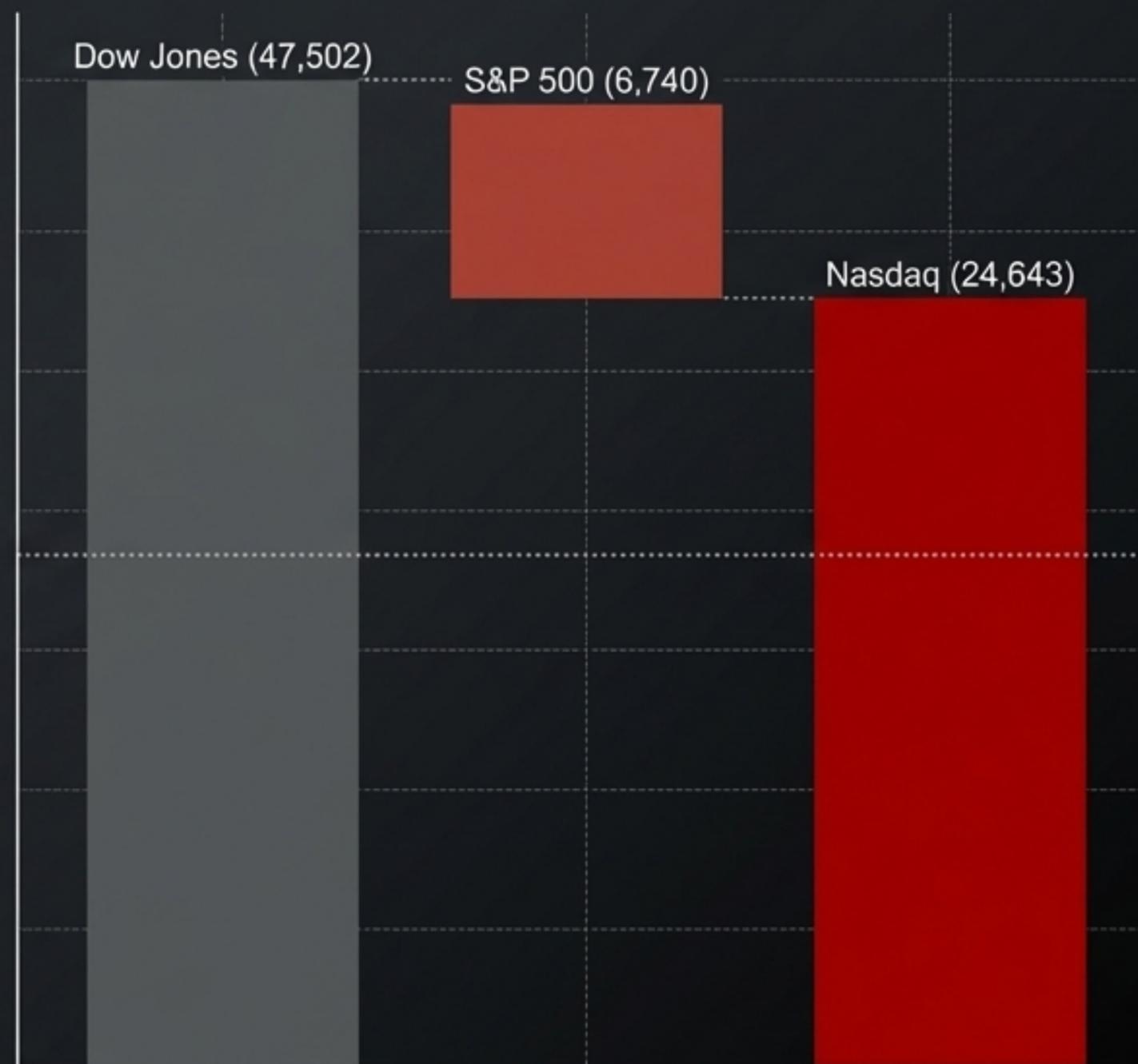
SECTION 2: REGIONAL ANALYSIS

Executive Title: Americas: Wall Street's Defensive Retreat

Key Insight: The stagflationary shock has ended earlier quarters' complacency, triggering heavy sell-offs in U.S. risk-on, high-beta assets.

Data Breakdown: S&P 500 closed at 6,740 (-1.33%, support at 6,650); Dow Jones plummeted to 47,502 (breaking 48k floor); Nasdaq 100 settled at 24,643 (-1.51%, support at 24,200).

Strategic Action: Indices are priced for a slowdown. Monday's session will likely see gap-down pressures; demand strict risk management and favor defensive value sectors over cyclical growth.



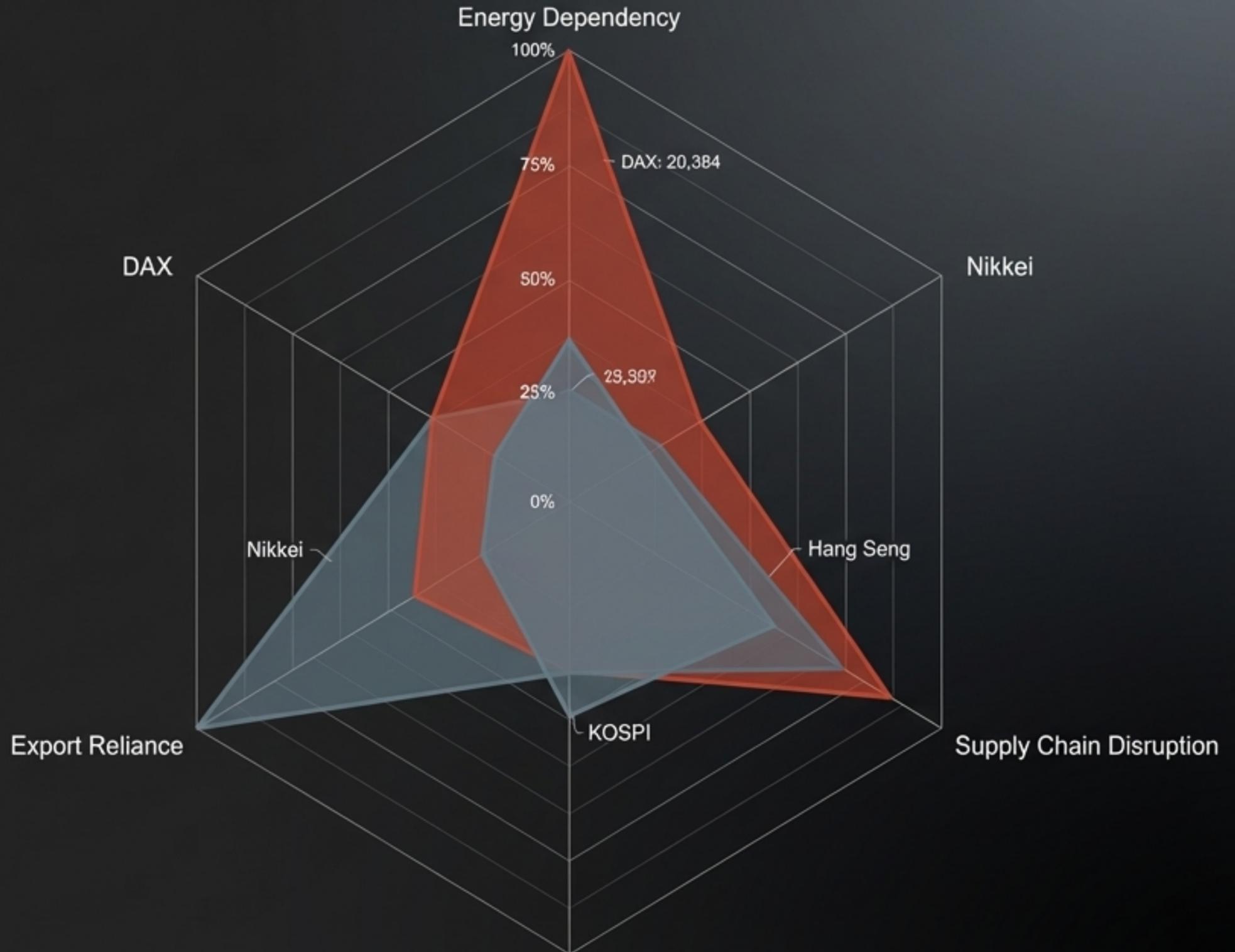
SECTION 2: REGIONAL ANALYSIS

Executive Title: Eurasia: Shadow Deflation & Asian Fragmentation

Key Insight: Europe faces a devastating fundamental reality due to manufacturing energy reliance, while Asian markets act as vulnerable first responders to the weekend's geopolitical shockwaves.

Data Breakdown: Germany's DAX plummeted to 20,384 (support at 20,000); Japan's Nikkei defensive at 55,300; Hang Seng sits precariously at 25,630; KOSPI retreats to 4,214.

Analyst Insight: The VSTOXX volatility index spike signals European asset managers are aggressively buying puts. Asian industrial output will suffer from inflated energy import bills until transit routes normalize.



SECTION 2: REGIONAL ANALYSIS

Executive Title: The Arab Anomaly: Energy Windfall Winners

Key Insight: Arab indices present a complex dichotomy: the geographic epicenter of the military storm is simultaneously the primary beneficiary of the resulting crude oil super-cycle.

Data Breakdown: Saudi TASI surged to 10,850 (support at 10,500, targeting 11,200); Dubai DFMGI closed at 4,320; Abu Dhabi ADX stabilized at 9,450.

Strategic Action: Institutional capital is expected to aggressively rotate into Gulf state energy heavyweights. Treat these specific Arab exchanges as a rare equity-based hedge against the broader stagflationary collapse.



Horizontal Bar Comparison

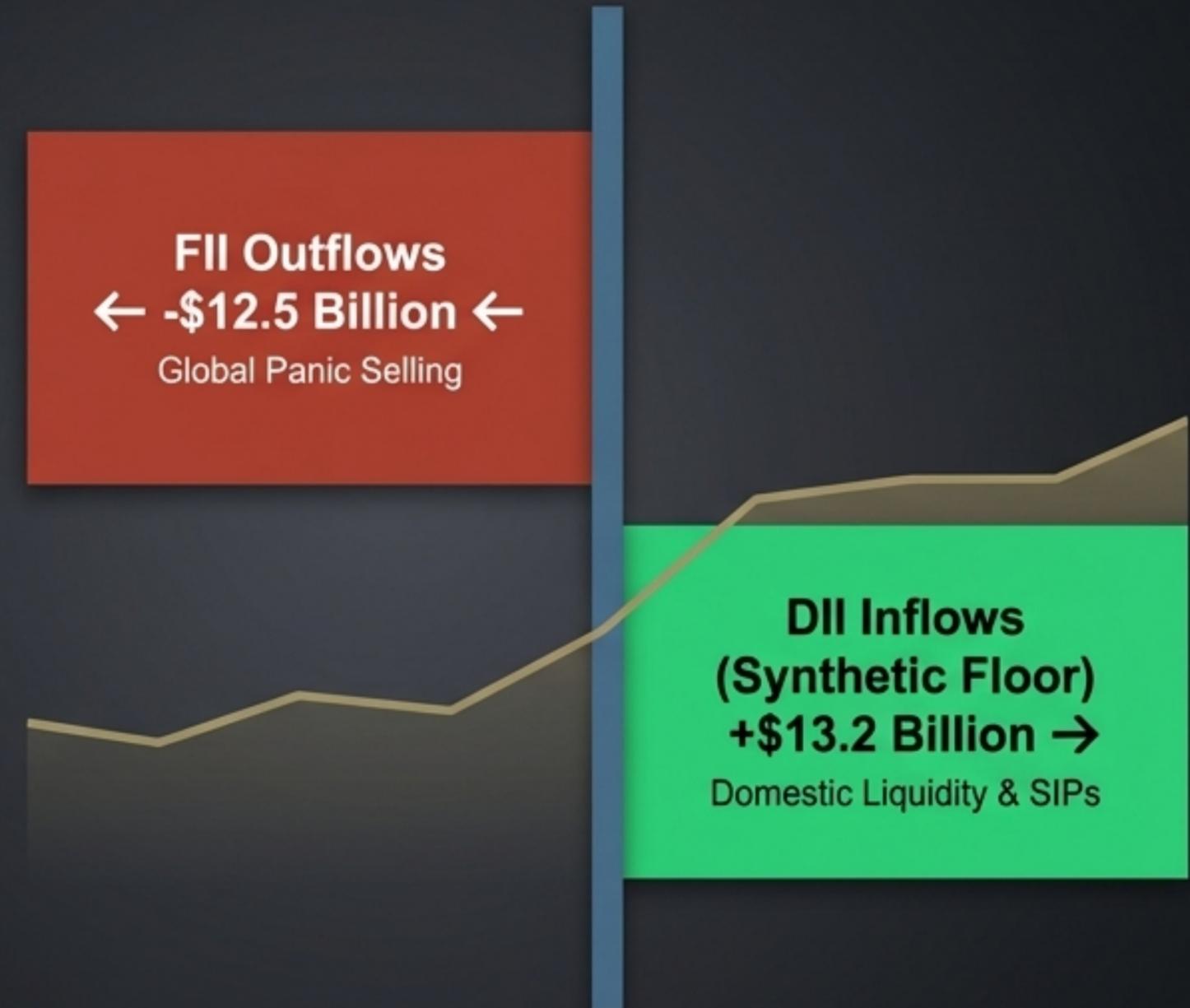
SECTION 3: DEEP DIVE INTO THE 'INDIAN SHIELD'

Executive Title: The Indian Shield: Institutional Decoupling Dynamics

Key Insight: A masterclass in "Institutional Decoupling." Despite global panic and massive FII sell-offs, Indian markets absorbed the shock due to historically strong DII buying.

Data Breakdown: Domestic SIP flows have established a synthetic floor, creating a "Liquidity Pivot" completely independent of Western panic sell-offs.

Analyst Insight: This decoupling demonstrates remarkable domestic resilience, but traders must remain exceptionally vigilant as exogenous macro pressures build against this domestic defense.



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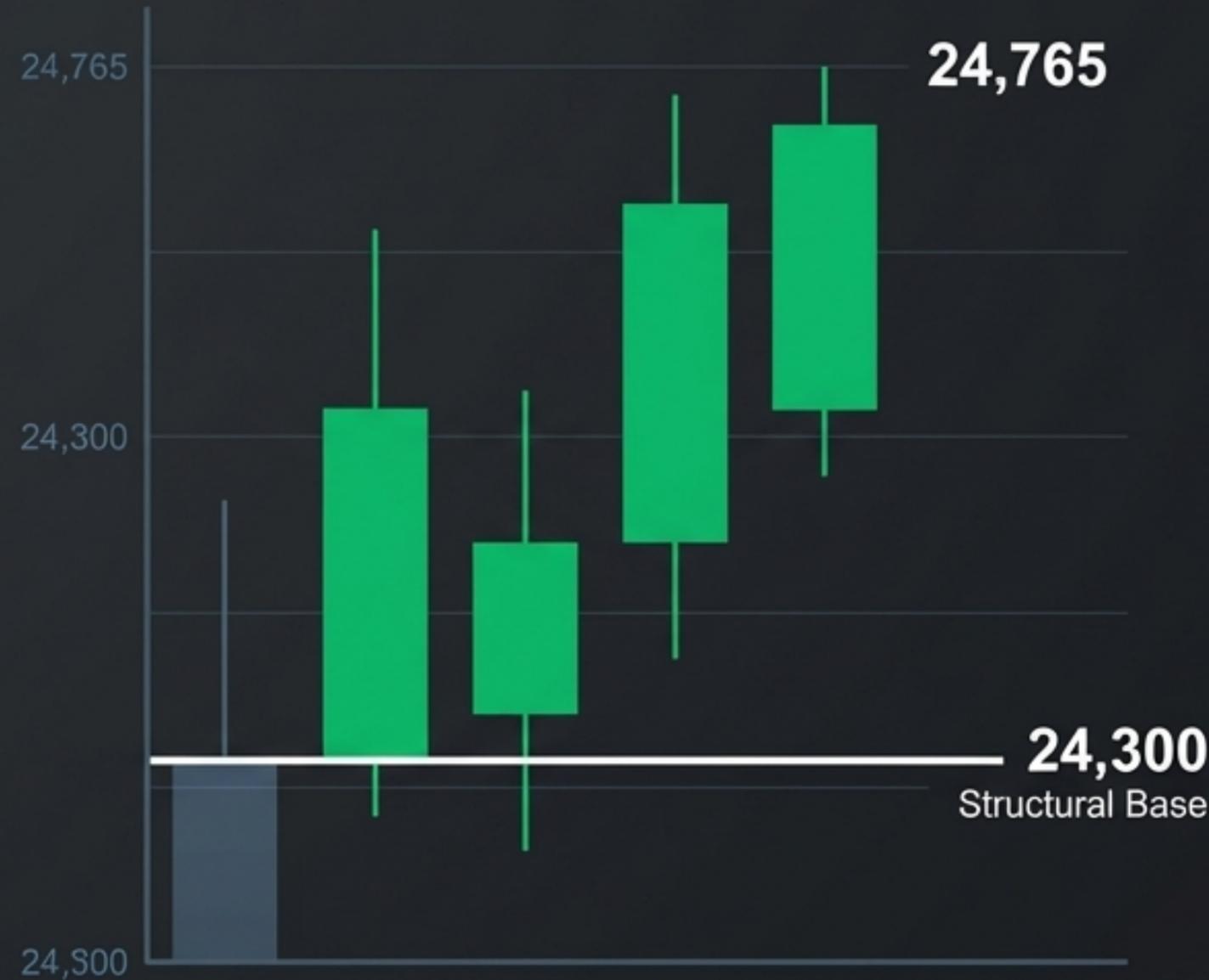
Executive Title: Nifty 50 Resilience vs. INR Vulnerability

Key Insight: While domestic equity acts as a shield, the Indian Rupee is under extreme fundamental pressure from the ballooning oil import bill caused by the Middle East crisis.

Data Breakdown: Nifty 50 rebounded to close near 24,765 (fiercely defending 24,300 support); USD/INR slipped to record lows near 92.30 before recovering slightly to 91.60.

Strategic Action: Maintain strict risk management. The Nifty faces resistance at 25,200, while the INR remains highly vulnerable with resistance stationed at the 92.50 all-time high. Any further military escalation could break this domestic defense.

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Risk Thermometer



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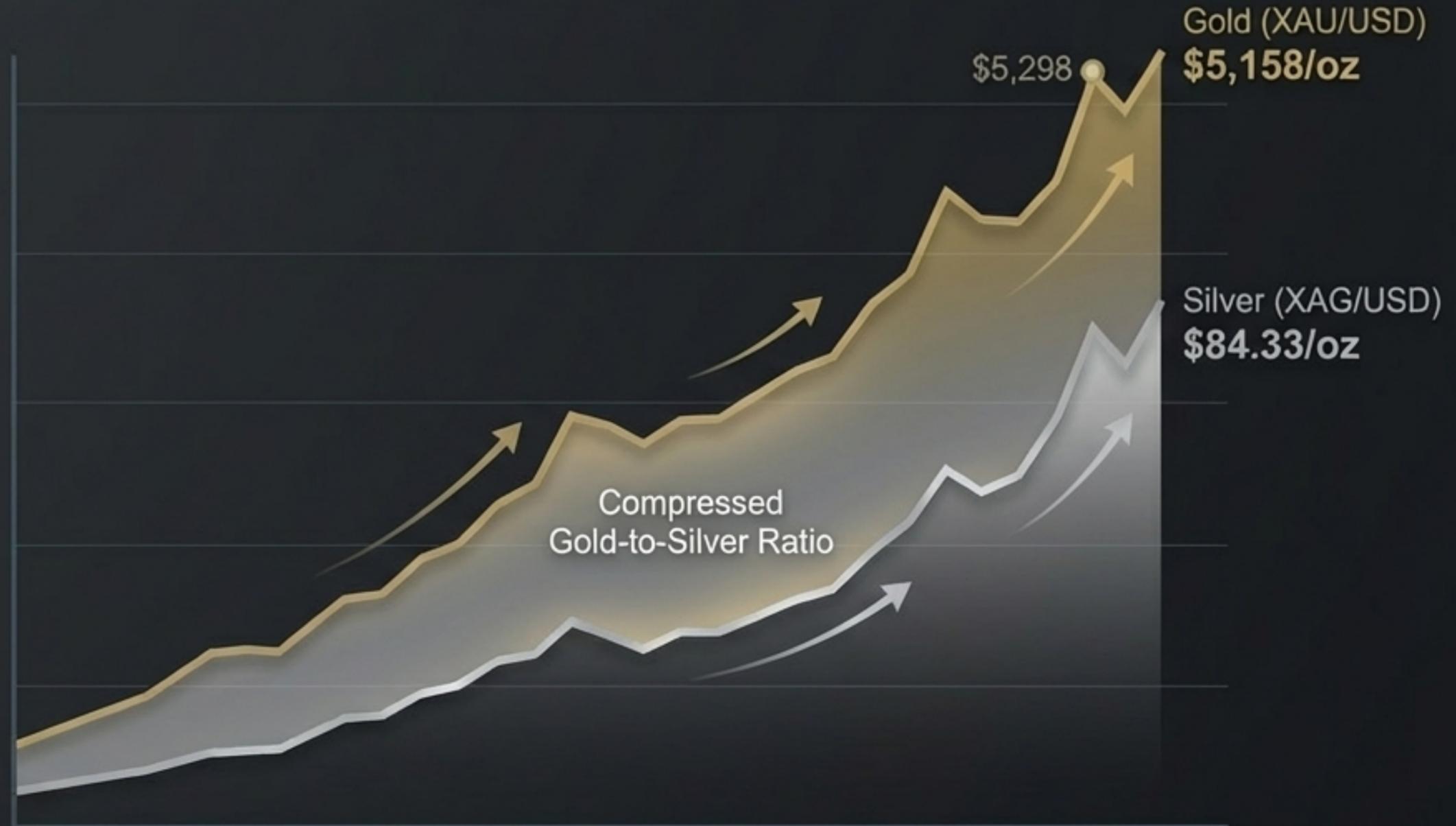
SECTION 4: TECHNICAL STRATEGY FOR CRYPTO & COMMODITIES

Executive Title: Precious Metals: The Ultimate Safe Havens

Key Insight: Precious metals have definitively reclaimed their status as the ultimate safe-haven assets amidst global geopolitical chaos and a stagflationary environment.

Data Breakdown: Gold (XAU/USD) blasted through historical ceilings to \$5,158/oz (intra-week highs near \$5,298); Silver (XAG/USD) rallied to \$84.33/oz (+2.51%), outperforming gold in percentage terms.

Strategic Action: The technical posture is overwhelmingly bullish. Any weakness in the U.S. dollar will be aggressively utilized by institutions to accumulate further. Support for Gold is firmly established at \$5,050.



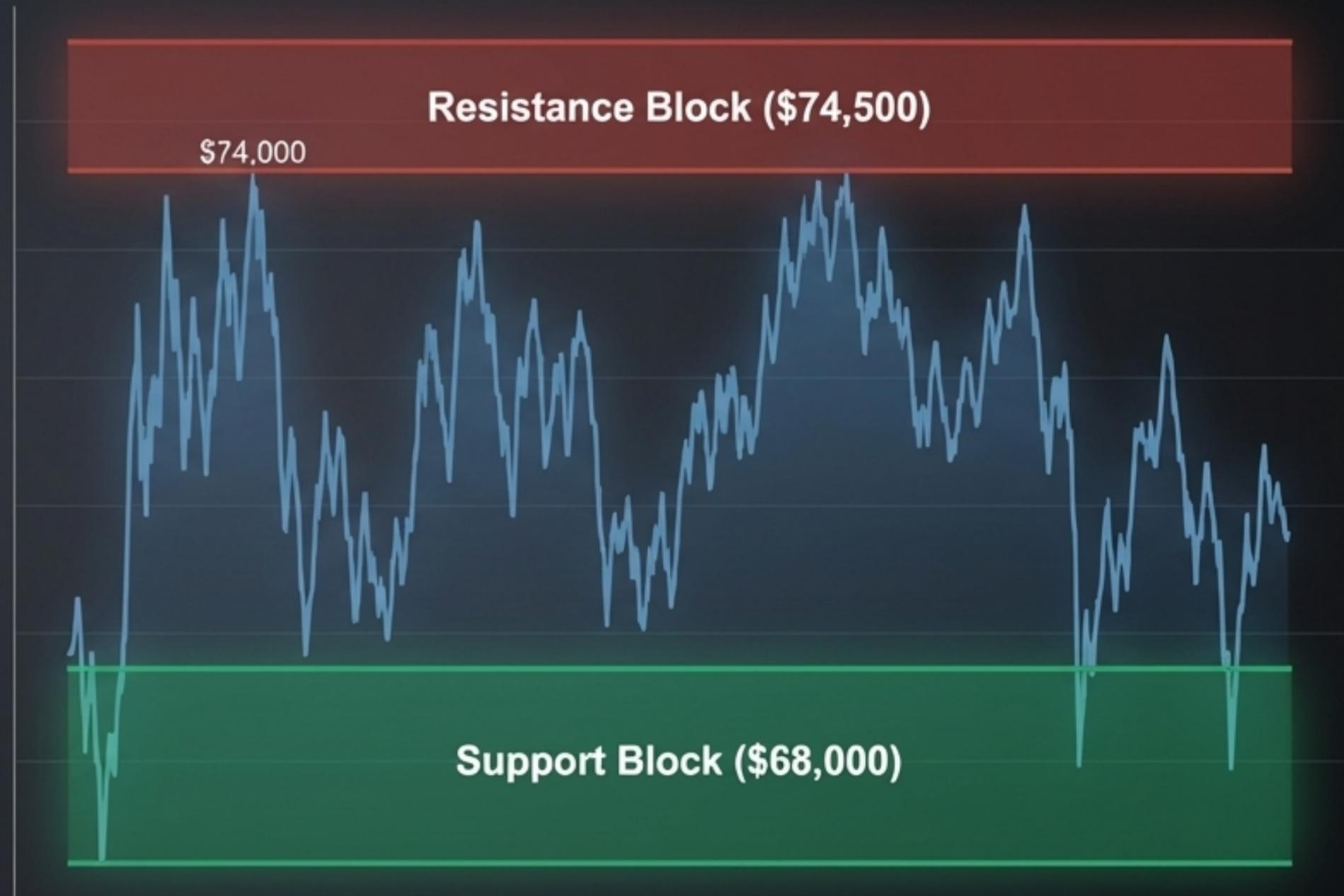
Trend Line Chart

Executive Title: Cryptocurrency: Volatile Stabilization

Key Insight: Crypto markets are experiencing extreme volatility, oscillating wildly between geopolitical safe-haven bids and high-beta risk-off liquidations.

Data Breakdown: Bitcoin (BTC) touched \$74,000 before liquidations dragged it to \$71,000–\$72,600; Ethereum (ETH) lags, trading sideways near \$2,066–\$2,066–\$2,126.

Analyst Insight: BTC navigates a dangerous pivot. Immediate support is fiercely guarded at \$68,000 with a \$74,500 resistance cap. If traditional equity sell-offs deepen, liquidity drains could drag the crypto complex lower toward the \$54,000 structural base.

Volatility Corridor Chart

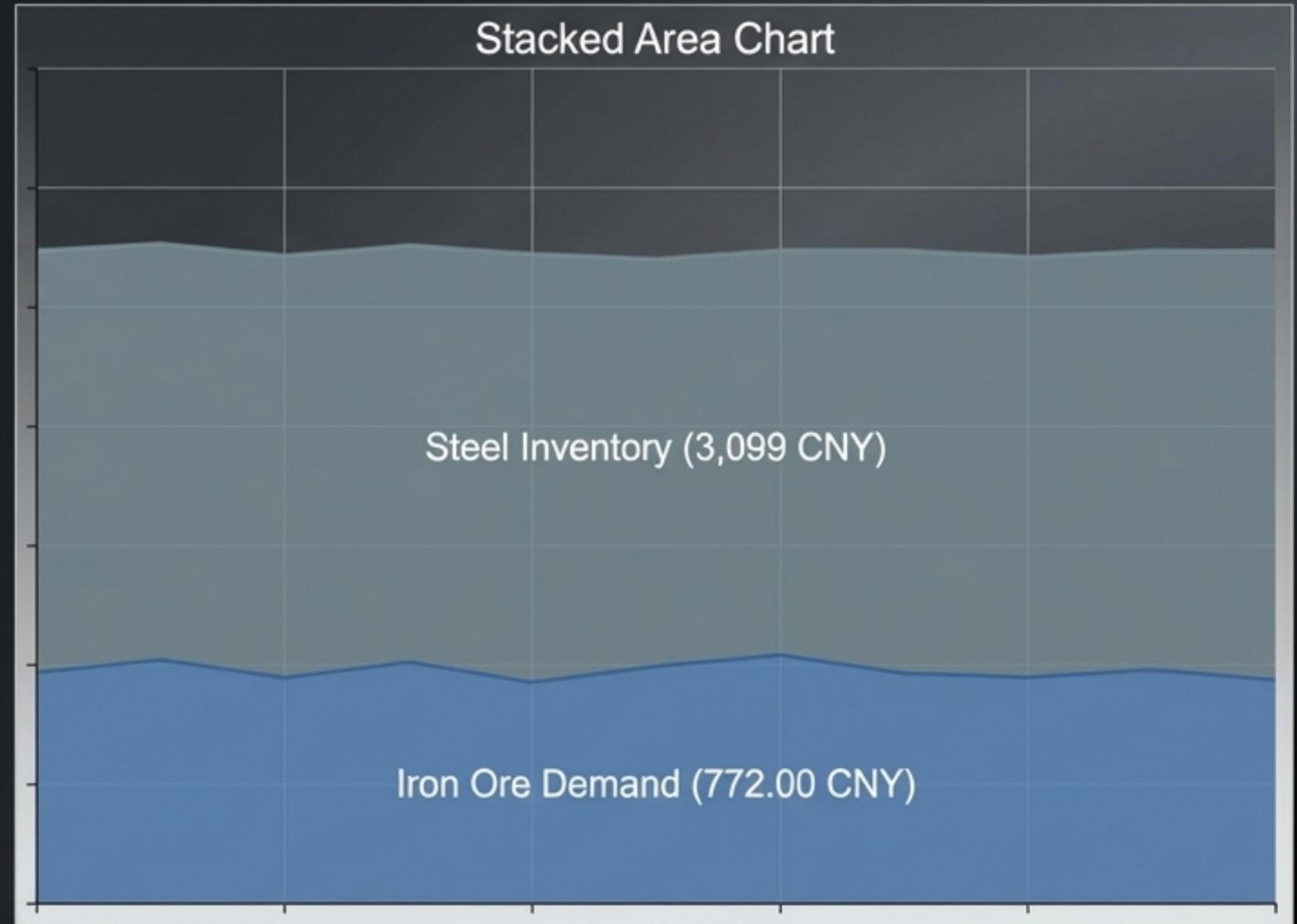
SECTION 4: TECHNICAL STRATEGY FOR CRYPTO & COMMODITIES

Executive Title: Industrial Commodities & Baseline Demand

Key Insight: Despite chaos in energy and equities, ferrous metals demonstrate steady resilience, insulated by targeted Asian industrial demand and Chinese stimulus measures.

Data Breakdown: Steel prices edged higher to **3,099 CNY/Tonne (+1.04%)**; Iron Ore closed at **772.00 CNY (+1.71%)**.

Strategic Action: The baseline demand curve remains intact, suggesting a sideways-to-bullish trajectory. Steel support rests at 3,000 (resistance 3,200); Iron Ore support at 750 (resistance 800).



WRAP-UP & COMPLIANCE

Executive Title: Impending Catalysts: March 9 Economic Calendar

Key Insight: Monday's data releases will set the tone for the week's inflation trajectory, particularly regarding Asian producer costs and U.S. consumer expectations.

Data Breakdown: 01:30 AM (GMT): China CPI (Forecast 0.2%) & PPI (Forecast -1.4%); 02:00 PM: US NY Fed 1-Year Consumer Inflation Expectations (Prev. 3.1%).

Strategic Action: Traders must observe these metrics closely. The NY Fed Inflation Expectations release (High Impact) will heavily influence intraday bond yields and DXY positioning.
